Dear Parent/Guardian:

I hope your summer is going well. I am pleased to inform you that we will be continuing Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the upcoming 2019-2020 school year. All students who participate in the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs will receive a free breakfast and lunch.

What does that mean for your child(ren) attending the schools at Granville?

All students enrolled at the Granville Central School District are eligible to receive a free breakfast and lunch at no charge to your household each day of the 2019-2020 school year. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application. However, we do not participate in the free milk program. Those who wish to have milk with a meal brought from home must purchase a container of milk. It is only free with your breakfast or lunch purchased from the school. Also you must have money in your accounts, bring cash or a check made out to Granville Central School Cafeteria that can be put into your account. We do not allow students to charge 2nd meals, snacks or drinks, etc. You can also make payments on-line at myschoolbucks.com with your students ID.

I am however asking that you will complete an Income Verification Form (enclosed) and return it to the school so that we can use the information for reporting purposes. The State Education Department uses the Household Income Eligibility Form information to determine our school funding and to fund other school related programs. Having the form will allow us to take advantage of student programs and provide parents with reduced student fee costs for items such as tests, advanced placement fees, Operation Santa Claus and other program opportunities for students. If your student is going off to college regardless of whether they participate in our meal programs or not and you know that you would normally qualify for the free or reduced meals please fill out the form so that the information can be given to guidance because there may be a reduced cost or no cost for testing.
